Evaluating sites for MetroPCS' Detroit wireless network locations

The Dallas-based wireless service provider used G2's services to detect any potential issues with proposed network locations in nine counties, including Oakland, Wayne, Macomb and Livingston.

At each site, G2 conducted environmental studies to identify any potential environmental contamination, endangered species, wetlands, floodplains, Native American burial grounds or historical sites that may exist.

G2 also analyzed soil samples taken from raw land sites to design foundations for MetroPCS' network communication towers. G2's designs considered tower height and wind and ice loading conditions.
